

A Letter from Father Max



Dear Blessed Sacrament Families/Friends,

Advent greetings from Father Max!

A FEW THINGS FOR YOUR INFORMATION

A month ago we undertook a major project of tuck-pointing around the Church and the Hall buildings. This project is now complete. The windows and control joints have been caulked and the lintels have been painted. The tuck-pointing on the bell tower, however, is pending due to more structural inspections and a review will be completed in the spring. As I mentioned earlier, the project will cost the parish around \$110,000.00.

Also, I wanted to bring to your kind attention that the **sound system in the Holy Family Hall will be upgraded** soon replacing the old equipment which I believe has served its purpose for the past 50 Years! The present PA system has been causing a few problems during the events. Since we have been holding more events, now some of which need the PA system, I thought of upgrading the same in order that we have a smooth flow of sound and communications. This project will cost the parish around \$6,000.00. I want to take this opportunity **to thank Ken Kish** for taking care of our PA system both in the church and the Holy Family Hall.

On December 15th, we will be celebrating another Children's Christmas Pageant and Parish Christmas Potluck after the 10:30 Mass. These gatherings are an opportunity for all of us to come together as a Parish community in the light of our 50th Parish Anniversary celebrations through 'Prayer and Presence', a theme that we have chosen to commemorate 50 years of Blessed Sacrament. I hope to see as many families as possible for this special performance put on by the children and then for food and fellowship in Holy Family Hall. As is tradition, a timely visitor dressed in red will stop by for a special appearance.

After consulting the Parish Council and Parish Staff, I have made a major change to our Christmas Eve Masses. Beginning this year, we will be having the Christmas Eve Masses at 4:00 pm, instead of 4:00 pm & 4:30 pm. Both Masses will be held simultaneously in the Church and the Holy Family Hall. I hope this change will help the faithful to attend the Christmas Eve Masses as early as 4:00pm which will then allow more time later in the evening for family gatherings. The 8:00 pm Mass on Christmas night and 9:00 am on Christmas morning will stay the same.

The Season of Advent calls us to "stay awake" and not sleep through the opportunities life gives us to discover God and His life changing spirit. Advent calls us to "watch," to pay attention to the signs of God's unmistakable presence in our lives and to live life expectantly as a gift from God. May we all discover the undying hope that Christ offers us as we prepare, once again, for the celebration of His birth.

May God bless you and your family in every good way.
